Cape care instructions

Cleaning

- The cape is not machine washable.
 - The outer is made from waxed cotton. This should be dry brushed or sponged cleaned. Harsh detergents will strip the waterproofing.
 - The inner is made from cotton or a polycotton mix. This can be sponge cleaned.
 - Dry in a ventilated area away from direct heat, ie not on a radiator.

Storage

- Store your cape in a ventilated area. Back of cupboards or against external walls tends to encourage mould growth, as with any natural fabric.
 - Long periods of folding will crease the cape but creases will drop out on wearing.
 - Wearing or gently warming with a hairdryer will reshape the cape.
- Leaving your cape in high temperatures, eg a hot car, may cause the wax to melt and build slightly in some areas of the fabric. This can be rubbed gently to redistribute.
- Waxes may transfer to absorbent surfaces if left in contact for long periods of time or in hot conditions. Take care when storing to avoid transfer.

Reproofing

- We recommend reproofing annually. The need for this will depend on amount of wear, however.
 - We recommend using a solid reproofing wax such as British Millerain, Granger's, Campbells or Barbour (wax or solid stick).
